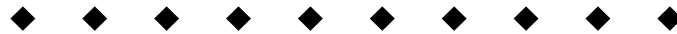
We wish you the very best of the holiday season and invite you to join us on December 13 for our year end membership meeting and Holiday Tea. We would love to say "thank you" in person.

Vote to Adopt Revised By-Laws: A by-laws revision committee was convened in early 2017 to update the by-laws to allow rolling membership and to reflect the changing needs of the organization. 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Spend Next Summer Learning at the University of Cambridge

Founded in 1869 Girton College is one of the constituent colleges of the University of Cambridge. This residential summer school gives lifelong learners from around the world the exceptional opportunity to experience something of Cambridge student life in the context of a program specifically designed for adult learners. Participants can choose to attend the full two-week program, Saturday 19 August – Saturday 1 September 2018 or opt to attend for just one week.

Various courses are offered in History, Literature, Art History and Architecture. Only an interest in the subject is required. There are no exams; participants study for the joy of learning. A varied social program is offered to help lifelong learners experience Cambridge to the full.
